This section of Boandik Kessal was constructed in 1995. The rooms have quality finishes and are refurbished when vacant. Furnishings are provided that meet the individual needs of the resident however residents are encouraged to personalise the rooms with furniture and soft furnishings. There are built in wardrobes in each room. Every room has individually controlled in room heating, landline telephone connection, nurse call points and is Wi-Fi enabled. The rooms look out onto attractive gardens, streetscapes and landscaped courtyards. The rooms are located in close proximity to communal areas including the lounge rooms, dining room, activity room, courtyard gardens and verandah. The shared bathrooms are located throughout the unit with a maximum of 3 residents sharing a bathroom.

Size of room (m²)

The rooms range in size from 13.26m² to 14.96m². This section has shared bathrooms.

Quality, condition, size and amenity of common areas

The Moore Court unit is one of 3 units of the Kessal site. It is a secure unit providing accommodation for people with high care needs living with dementia. The unit has 2 lounge rooms, dining room, activity room, sitting nooks as well as verandah and external courtyards. The residents have access to the large communal areas located in other areas of the building. These areas include library, hairdressing salon, meeting room, cafe area and shop and a large activity room that accommodates 80 people. There is also a chapel on site that has weekly church services. All communal areas have recently been refurbished.

Specific accommodation or design features of the room and of the home

The Kessal home is co-located with the Sutton home and a small retirement village. It is in close proximity to a school, kindergarten, local shopping centre and bus stop.

The Hawkins and Moore Court rooms have an overhead hoist system. The rooms look out onto attractive gardens, streetscapes and landscaped courtyards. The rooms are located in close proximity to communal areas including the lounge room, dining room, sitting areas, courtyards, gardens and spa bathroom.

Size of room (m²)

The rooms range in size from 17.2m² to 18.96m² providing space for a sitting area. The ensuites are designed to suit the needs of the individual ranging in size from 5.43m² to 5.53m².
